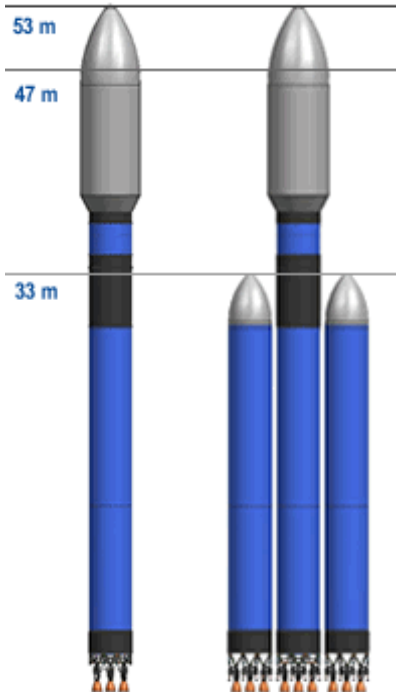
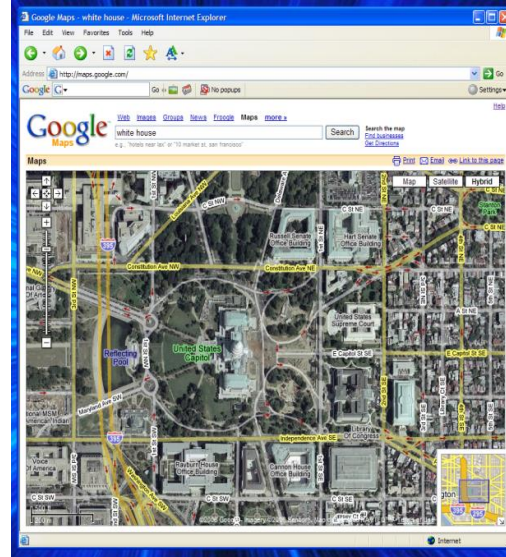
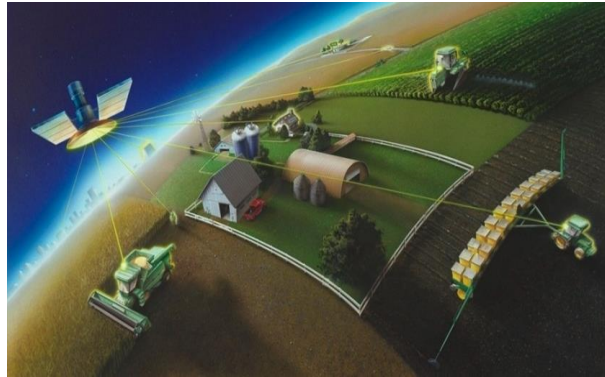


OSC Overview
